

### Venue for DGS



Most of you will have realised that we had a last minute panic regarding a venue for our meeting in January. Luckily, Greyfriars were able to assist and we could meet as usual but it seems there are potential long term issues with our current St Andrew's venue.

Sue has been in contact with St Andrew's to find that despite sending our 2026 list of meetings to them back in early November, they are unable to accommodate us for the time being and potentially permanently.

The reason for this is that they wish to reserve Sundays for church use and so are no longer offering the hall for hire.

This obviously leaves us in a bit of a situation with a need to find a suitable permanent alternative as soon as possible.

Greyfriars in Ringwood have been very helpful and are able to accommodate us for February. They are also keen for us to rehome there and can provide storage for our library too. The cost to hire is also favourable. However, we understand that for some of you, Ringwood is a bit further to travel so we would like to explore other options before we commit to any permanent change in a bid to suit everyone.

Therefore, we are asking your help to suggest any venues that you think may be suitable. To help further, if you are able to make initial contact with any suggested venue and enquire about Sunday afternoon hire (1:30-5:30pm) along with storage

space (enough for 2 standard filing cabinets) that would help us greatly as will hopefully leave us with a list of viable options to discuss.

We can then have a discussion next meeting about the way forward.

## January Teatime Talent Performances

Many thanks to Mark Armitage for his performance of [Rosita by Antonio Manjon](#). This is a composer I hadn't come across before so I did a little Googleing....



Antonio Jiménez Manjón, 1866-1919 was born in Villacarillo, Jaén, in the part of Spain known as Andalusia, became blind when still a young child. Little is known about his early life, though he performed a recital in Paris in 1889. In 1893 he went to South America and settled in Buenos Aires, returning to Europe for a concert tour in 1912-13. He met the great Paraguayan guitarist, Agustín Barrios, in Montevideo in 1912 and gave him some tuition. It is also said that after hearing a concert by Manjón in 1889, the Catalan maestro, Miguel Llobet, decided to make the guitar his lifetime's occupation.

Hopefully you are all managing to find the scores via my OneDrive folder. Parts for Dance of the Knights are there- along with the others. Please use the link below to access.


